# davidsons & *beyond* composites

**A**strologers always do the horoscopes of someone else. We're supposed to be above it, we are the professionals...

But this was so illustrative of me and my ex-wife. It is one of the dangers of being an astrologer. You have to be careful of not falling in love with the horoscope first! That is why I am soured on synastry.

Compare the charts: Chart One—Bob Marks—and Chart Two (*red.*, all charts can be found in the Appendix). Her Sun is in Pisces right on my Ascendant, practically to the degree, sextile my Sun, trine my Mercury, sextile my Uranus. Her Moon is opposite my Moon, on my Sun, sextile my Ascendant. Do you get the picture? It's one thing after another. We even had Venus and Mars making sextiles. The only bad thing was my Saturn squaring her Venus. Well...what a tremendous chart! Alright.

This is why synastry is limited, very, very limited. Synastry will say, oh, you can get along here; you won't get along there. It doesn't say if the relationship will go on or not. The first thing you have to do is check your own horoscope and check the relationship area, and the other person's too. I would have noticed—I almost forgot it; I didn't notice it until later—that Uranus

was transiting square my Ascendant. Now I said to myself, "It's lovely. Uranus has such an undeserved reputation. Why, I've never been so much in love before. It's like getting struck by lightning." Lightning flashes for a moment and then it's gone... Now get this: she also had Uranus in her solar return around three or four degrees above her Ascendant. So in three or four months, that is when we met. She was engaged at the time. She left him, sold her business and moved to New York. We got married, and a few months later, woke up, looked at each other and said, "What did we do?" I picked a good time for the marriage so it was a very friendly divorce. (Laughter) That's when I said, maybe I should get a little more into relationship astrology.

Chart Three is the Davidson chart for my ex-wife and myself. First of all, there is the Moon in the twelfth house. Doesn't that indicate that the

obsessed with this? Where is Pluto? In the fifth house square a conjunction of the Sun and the Moon. A conjunction of the Sun and the Moon means that this was a significant relationship. I would say it was pretty significant in his life. Oh yes, his public image—forget his public image. Saturn is the ruler of his public image and it is sitting on Neptune opposite Venus.

What happened with Monica? (Lewinsky/Clinton Marks Chart) Oh, Monica, the Sun and Venus in the seventh house squaring Jupiter and squaring Juno. She actually thought that they had something there. Well, it is Jupiter so she came out of it with just a few bumps and bruises—and a reputation that you wouldn't believe. Let's go back to her chart. If you notice, she has only one planet in a water sign. Now in my experience when you have one planet standing out, it is able to funnel all the energy of the horoscope. And in her case, it is Mercury in the tenth house. First of all, it means that your words are more likely to come before the public. It also means that the public will be talking about you.

AUDIENCE: *What do you mean about a funnel?*

BM: It is able to act literally as a funnel. As a matter of fact, you might want to [read my lecture transcript on Singletons, *red.*]. The first chart I looked at was J.P. Morgan's. He had the Moon in Virgo and it was his only earth sign. So it funneled all of his energy. He had an emotional need for business and accumulating wealth. If you look at Bill Clinton's chart, he has only one planet in earth. That planet is able to funnel all the energy of his chart in the same way. What house is the Moon in in Bill Clinton's chart? The eighth house. Gee, sex, credit and other

people's money. He is the president of the United States—he has control over the budget. As for the rest, you already know that. If you have one planet standing out in your chart, that can be the most important planet. I did an article on this back in 1974 or '75. When I showed it to the editor, he said. "That's it. That's it." "What's 'it'?" Well, he knew this woman who had only one planet in an earth sign, and he couldn't figure out why she had plants all over her apartment. It wasn't like a garden; it was like a forest. I asked him what was the one earth planet? Mars in Virgo. All of her energy went into gardening—Virgo.

Okay, let's get back to the Marks chart for Monica Lewinski. Saturn is in the twelfth house. Where is Capricorn? On the MC. What effect does this have on her public image? (Laughter). I mean, you have heard all those jokes—that I can't repeat. The Moon in the first house—she was highly emotional. The Moon is widely opposite the Sun—nothing permanent, just a fling. But because of Jupiter she would probably be making more out of it than it actually was. Now, you don't have to do this just for romantic relationships. You can do it for enemies as well. Yes, Ken Starr. The world's last Cancer. Adjacent signs can drive each other crazy. Because the sign before you, that is your solar twelfth house; that is your hidden enemy. But at the same time, they can feel horribly restricted by you. I have found this again and again. Whenever you get people with adjacent signs having a conflict, the first time they have the conflict the first sign wins. The second time the other sign learns how to deal with it. Alexander Hamilton, the Capricorn. Aaron Burr, the Aquarian. Hamilton fixed it so that Burr would never get elected President. So he won the first battle. The second battle we all know about: Burr charged Hamilton to a duel and killed him.
