
the astrology of *murderers* & *serial killers*

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In my analysis of the charts of murderers and serial killers, I found some things like the Moon making a stressful aspect to Mars, which you would expect, especially for a lot of these killers...

Because what is the Moon in the horoscope? Women, the mother. Mars is violence. Richard Speck had the Moon square Mars at the angles of the chart. But I also found Moon square Venus. have a back yard so he would try to flush them down the toilet. The body parts got stuck though and there was a terrible odor. That is how they caught him. See, a Sagittarius—he pushed his luck. Gee... He's got the Moon sitting on top of Saturn, and he has Venus ruling and opposite the eighth house. Again, the opposition. Oppositions just seem to be deadly. Even more so than the square or the conjunction. But he also has that Venus making a square to Pluto. What degree is his Sun? 0° Sagittarius 31', exactly opposite Ken Bianchi's. Interesting degree. Again, it's that aspect. I am sure that this one was only a coincidence. Right... Mercury is the ruler of his twelfth house but Venus was actually the ruler of his twelfth house too. It rules most of it. Mercury doesn't do all that much.

Jeffrey Dahmer. There are more jokes going on in relation to him than anybody else. How the city of Milwaukee was going to have to change its name to Hackensack. (Laughter). Or the horrible one where he invited somebody to dinner and the fellow said, "Jeffrey. I don't like your friends." And he said, "That's alright. Try the noodles." (Laughter).
